

The “Ponderosa” is an association of volunteers. The Board of Trustees are volunteers elected from the membership, and the committees, and committee chairs are volunteers! We’re in need of Committee chairs, co-chairs, and members for the coming year.

The Ponderosa has four standing committees that serve in support of the Club’s Mission to create and maintain a safe and welcoming community, which enhances recreational and residential living through active membership participation and commitment to sustainability & harmony with the natural environment; Buildings and Grounds, Watershed, Social, and Elections.

Please keep in mind that it takes each of us volunteering just a little bit to keep our community the way we like it. Those of us who are already volunteering encourage those of you who are not to offer your help and become involved. It requires no prior experience or special expertise, although if you have either of these they are most welcome. We encourage you to become an active participant in your Ponderosa Community.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee identifies, recommends, plans and develops various buildings and grounds projects to enhance PCC facilities. This group meets, usually on a designated weekend, for projects related to our pool landscaping, playground, and ballfield areas.

The Watershed Enhancement Committee is dedicated to the development, improvement, and enjoyment of greenbelt reserves. This group meets, usually for a couple of hours on selected weekends, at a Greenbelt. They maintain trails, remove noxious weeds, clear brush, spread bark, place benches and signs, etc.

The Social Committee plans, organizes, and directs social and fund-raising activities, which involve the Ponderosa’s facilities, except those fund-raising activities which have been assigned to the Treasurer. This group meets occasionally to plan social events. They are also responsible for staffing these events and arranging for food or drink when appropriate.

The Elections Committee is charged with the responsibility of Administering the Election Procedures and validating and counting all ballots.
